Mathematics

To support the children in this area of learning we will:

- Practise counting daily as part of our morning routine (up to 20)
- Sing the days of the week song
- Compare amounts (which is bigger or smaller and discuss how we know)
- Use size language such as big and small to talk about objects
- Explore shapes and practise matching and naming them (circle, square, rectangle, triangle, star, heart, hexagon)
- Find shapes in the environment.

Physical Development.

To support the children in this area of learning we will:

- Practise putting on coats and doing up zips
- Explore and learn how to use one-handed tools effectively such as paint brushes, scissors or pencils
- Use the climbing frame, scooters and balance bikes to continue developing movement and balance
- Support the children to collaborate when using large wooden blocks or other items
- Move with control and co-ordination in a range of ways in time to music.

Religious Education:

MYSELF: During the Myself topic the children will learn and understand the importance of their own name and that God loves them and knows them.

WELCOME: Throughout this topic the children will learn what it is to welcome others and to be welcomed. They will begin to understand Baptism as being welcomed into Gods Family and their Church family.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

To support the children in this area of learning we will:

- Introduce the children to the Nursery and whole school rules and routines
- Introduce short whole class and small group interactive sessions
- Talk about our families' using photographs shared from home
- Try out new activities and support children to select resources independently
- Support children to begin to show awareness of own and others needs (personal care, empathy, sharing).

Expressive art and design:

Throughout the half term we will explore;

- Colour mixing
- Naming the primary colours
- Using a variety of art materials safely
- Making observational drawings and paintings of faces using mirrors and pictures
- The use of different materials and textures to create collages of their own face.
- The children will begin their exciting music lessons with Mr Patrick where they will have a range of instruments to experiment with and use.
- Through the use of role play the children will engage in a range of narratives and storylines linked to our topic.
