CS First Storytelling

In Storytelling, students use computer science to tell fun and interactive stories using Scratch.

Children will have the opportunity to collect, present and analyse data using a variety of different software programmes.

Mathematics

Time

- To read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute; record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours
- To compare durations of events
- To read the time using a 24h clock and use am and pm.

Shape

- To identify angles and turns
- To compare angles
- To identify horizontal and vertical lines
- To identify parallel and perpendicular lines
- To recognise and describe 2D shapes

Statistics

- To interpret and draw bar charts and pictograms
- To collect and represent data

Music - Reflect, Rewind, Replay

Listening and appraising music from a variety of genres, singing and playing on tuned and untuned percussion instruments.
