Mayor's (Greater London Authority) Funding of Free School Lunches for <u>Junior Children</u> 2023/2024

Although the Mayor's initiative means that all Junior pupils can get free school meals for this academic year, it is still <u>really</u> important that where any pupil is eligible for means-tested free school meals parents should apply for them. This has several benefits:

- they are eligible for meal vouchers in the school holidays
- the school benefits from pupil premium funding which is linked to the claim
- the Mayor's scheme is currently only funded through to July 24, so where pupils are eligible for means-tested meals they can continue to receive these once the Mayor's scheme ends.
