This year it will be extra special, as it will be the first Summer Fayre for all the children in Nursery and Infant Schools. The day itself will be filled with amazing attractions and stunning stalls, along with typical Fayre food. We will be entertained by various acts on the main stage and enjoy watching our children perform.

The theme for this year's Summer Fayre is My World, a celebration of the wonderful diversity that enhances our school community. To make this Summer Fayre a resounding success, we need your help. Over the next few weeks, we will be making the following requests:

Volunteering opportunities:

Fayre: On the day before and on the day of the Fayre, we will need lots of hands to help setup, run and tidy-up the site afterwards (timings to be confirmed). Volunteering will be coordinated via the class reps.

- 8-Jul, 15:15 to 17:30 (TBC). Prepping, including but not limited to tagging the tombolas. Erecting tents, weather permitting.
- 9-Jul, There are many ways you can help on the day. Each class/year group will be allocated a stall and will be in charge of running it on the day, including setup and dismantling. So keep an eye out closer to the event to find out which stall you will be supporting. Each stall will need the following, so a target of 16 volunteers per class should be aimed for:
 - 10am to noon (2 volunteers minimum) final setup: tents if needed, along with final staging of the stall.
 - Noon to 3pm (12 volunteers minimum) running the stall, it is suggested that 2 volunteers are on each stall for half an hour at a time.
 - 3pm to 5pm (2 volunteers minimum) dismantling the stall and fayre

Donations:

- Sports Day TBC: New sports equipment for the sports tombola – think active, for example: sports balls, skipping ropes, frisbees, skateboards.
- 8-Jul: Bottles for bottle tombola. As a thank you, the children will be treated to a mufti day.
- Date TBC: Raffle tickets to sell and buy. These will be issued to each child.

Other ways to help:

Please contact us via your class rep if you can help in any of the following ways:

- **Hunters Estate Agents Board host:** We are looking for parents and carers who would be willing to have a Hunters estate agency board placed outside their house (sorry, no flats) for approximately 3 weeks in the run-up to the Summer Fayre. Not only do the boards help to promote the Fayre within our community, but Hunters will also make a donation for each board that is placed. The board will read along the lines of “Hunters Carshalton are proud to sponsor St Mary’s Summer Fayre”. Let us know if you are willing to have a board placed outside your house.
- **Performances:** Can you dance? Whether it's Irish Dancing, the Mazurka, the Tango, the Shaku Shaku, Flamenco, the Can-Can, Salsa, Kathakali, Calypso or anything in between, we'd love to hear from you! We're looking for parents and/or children who can do a little demonstration and teach us a couple of steps so we can learn some new moves in time for the festival season. We also have a choir of Italian children who will delight us with a lovely song. If your child would like to join them, let us know. If any of you have a similar idea, contact us.
