From the 25th May 2018, new regulations will be introduced which affect how our School handle people's data, called the General Data Protection Regulation. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is a piece of EU-wide legislation which will determine how people's personal data is processed and kept safe, and the legal rights individuals have in relation to their own data. Compliance with the regulations will be an ongoing process and the Schools have appointed a data protection officer to advise and manage compliance with the regulation.
